

Restricted Goods



At IndiaOne Air, the safety of our passengers and crew is our utmost priority. To ensure a secure journey for everyone, we strictly prohibit the carriage of any dangerous goods on our aircraft or hazardous items and substances that pose significant risks to all on board.

Check that none of the things listed below are in your cabin or checked-in Baggage before check-in.

Tips for carrying Baggage and Prohibited Items

Items similar the ones listed below are prohibited from becoming checked baggage, cabin baggage, or carry-on luggage when travelling on one of our flights. The list provided below is comprehensive, and current laws will be followed.

Prohibited Items in Hand Baggage		
Weaponry and Shooting Devices	Weapons such as ammunition, guns, compressed air guns, firearms and their components, pellet guns, realistic firearm replicas, and starter pistols.	
Personal Items	Personal articles such as Lighters, Scissors-metal with pointed tips and Realistic replica of toy weapon.	
Sporting Equipment's	Sporting gear such as Baseball Bats, Spear Guns, Bows and Arrows, Cricket Bats, Golf Clubs, Hockey Sticks, Lacrosse Sticks, Pool Cues and Ski Poles.	
Edged Tools and Pointed Instruments	Tools such as Axes and hatchets, Cattle Prods, Crowbars, Hammers, Drills (including cordless portables power drills), Saws (including cordless portable power saws), Screwdrivers, Other Tools, Wrenches and Pliers. Box Cutters, Ice Axes/Ice Picks, Knives, and Meat Cleavers, Razor-type blades, utility knives and razor blades not in a cartridge.	
Martial or Defensive equipment	Equipment such as Billy Clubs, Black Jacks, Night Sticks, Nunchakus, Martial Arts/Self Defense Items, Stun Guns/Shocking Devices, Throwing Stars, Brass Knuckles, Kubatons, Mace/Pepper Spray and Martial Arts Weapons,	

Prohibited items in Hand Baggage and even Checked-In Baggage	
Flammable and Ignition Items	Flammable items Such as Aerosol, Fuels including cooking fuels and any flammable liquid fuel, Gasoline, Gas Torches, Lighter Fluid, Strike anywhere matches Turpentine and Paint Thinner, Realistic Replicas of Incendiaries.
Oxidizing Substances	Substances Such as bleaching powder & peroxides.
Compressed Gases	Gases Such as deeply refrigerated, flammable, non-flammable and poisonous, Butane, Oxygen, Liquid nitrogen and Aqualung cylinders.
Radio-active &Corrosives Materials	Materials Such as acids, alkalis, mercury, wet cell batteries (except those in wheelchairs), oven or drain cleaners & Radio-active components.
Explosive Materials	Explosives Such as Flare Guns, Gun Lighters and Gun Powder, Explosive material, Blasting caps, Dynamite, Fireworks, Flares (in any form), Hand Grenades, Plastic Explosives and Realistic Replicas of Explosives.
Other Harmful articles	Hazardous items Such as magnetized, offensive or irritating materials. Briefcases and attaché cases with installed alarm devices, weed killers, and live virus materials.
Weapons	There is no provision to carry weapons and ammunition on IOA aircraft

List of Other Prohibited Items:

- For safety reasons, you cannot carry E-Cigarettes.
- Power Bank is not allowed in the Check-in baggage. You may carry in the hand baggage.
- As per the notice issued by the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security Government of India, passengers boarding an IndiaOne Air aircraft will **not** be allowed to carry in their hand baggage or on person liquids, gels or aerosols which include beverages, shampoo, suntan lotion, creams, tooth paste, hair gels, hair spray, liquid cosmetics or any other items of similar consistency, exceeding 100ml, except medicines, inhalers accompanied by prescriptions and baby food. These items will be carried in a clear transparent re-sealable one litre size plastic bag and will be subjected to the prescribed screening and security checks.
- IndiaOne Air suggests that all medication, valuables, delicate objects, perishable products and precious items (cameras, jewelry, money, electronics, etc.) should be transported in Cabin Baggage and not in Checked in Baggage. IndiaOne Air does not take any kind of responsibility for these goods and items.
- As per Indian law, Passengers travelling on flights with point of origin and destination both being within India, on an Indian registered aircraft are permitted to carry a 'Kirpan' in person. The dimensions of the 'Kirpan' must not exceed a total maximum length of 9 inches (22.86 cms), including the length of the blade not exceeding 6 inches (15.24 cms) and the length of the handle not exceeding 3 inches (7.62 cms). Exceeding the above dimension, Carriage of 'Kirpan' is not permitted in the cabin of an aircraft either on person or in the Hand Baggage on any Domestic flight. The same must be carried by the passenger in the checked-in baggage only.

**The contents will be screened and security checked and must adhere to IndiaOne Air's security requirements on allowed objects. **

Dangerous Articles in Baggage

The following items are normally considered dangerous goods carried by the passengers are subject to the provisions and approvals of the rules and regulations. The Limited quantities will be accepted for following items:

- Alcoholic Drinks with seal allowed maximum up to 5 liters after verified by the Airline security before check-in at the airport.
 - The alcoholic beverage should ideally be in retail packaging and packed appropriately.
 - Alcohol content in the beverage should not be above 70%
- Battery cells / Dry cells carried in the Cabin Baggage or in any electrical/ electronic items are liable
 to be removed and IndiaOne Air may not be able to return such removed items same at the
 Passenger's destination. We recommend that such items be carried in Checked Baggage.
 - Small lithium battery-powered vehicles such as air wheels, solo wheels, hover boards, mini-Segway and balance wheels are unacceptable to be carried

For safety reasons, dangerous articles, such as those listed below, must not be carried in passenger's baggage:

- Items, the carriage of which is prohibited by applicable laws, regulations or orders; Compressed gases: deeply refrigerated, flammable, non-flammable and poisonous such as butane, oxygen, liquid nitrogen, aqualung cylinders and compressed gas cylinders.
- The amount of dry ice shall not be allowed inside the baggage.
- Personal Mobility Aids (PMAs), Remote Devices like Drone as like such items are not allowed.
- SAMSUNG GALAXY NOTE 7, Mac book Pro laptops sold between Sep 2015 and Feb 2017 due to
 possible overheating while using is banned and cannot be carried in either baggage.
